- 1. <u>Call to Order</u> Quorum present Chair Weichers called the meeting to order at 7:31 a.m.

- 3. <u>Approval of Minutes</u>

Mayor Knopp moved to approve the minutes from the August 15, 2023, UFA Board Meeting as submitted

 - Benefits & Compensation Committee Chair Dahle
 - No meeting held
 - Governance Committee Chair Silvestrini

 - Finance Committee Chair Henderson

- 6. <u>Fire Safety Trailer/Fire Prevention Week</u>
 - DOC Easton explained that 2-years ago, IO requested budget for a new trailer
 - This was a custom built, state of the art trailer with many features
 - The goal is to have this available this coming month for use at community events
 - DOC Easton reminded Board Members that they will need to reach out to reserve the trailer
 - As the trailer is quite technical, staff will also need to be available to staff it
 - Following the UFA Board Meeting, members of both UFA and the UFSA Boards will be given the opportunity to tour the trailer
 - This preview was noticed and neither Board will take any action
 - Fire Prevention Week October 8-14, 2023
 - Fire Marshal Larson stated that most fires start in the kitchen, and this is the theme for the week

- Information will be distributed to all municipalities for posting on their social media pages
- Fire Prevention is also planning on distributing safety information to multi-family residential units for distribution to residents
- 7. <u>Operations Report</u>
 - Assistant Chief Dern will present this report each meeting going forward
 - If any Board Members wish to see different data included on the report, please reach out to AC Dern
 - This report is a result of feedback during the SWOC (Strengths, Weaknesses, Opportunities, Challenges) meetings for the Strategic Plan
 - The feedback express interest in knowing what the crews do day-to-day
 - AC Dern provided data on turnout times, number of calls, types of calls, etc.
 - Chief Burchett noted that a 10% improvement in turnout time was identified in the last Standard of Cover
 - Time has improved by 6 seconds
 - Crew Recognition
 - Crew recognition was given for a motor vehicle accident in CWH
 - Many crews and specialties were necessary and all who participated did an excellent job which resulted in a positive outcome
 - The crews will also be recognized at an upcoming CWH Council Meeting

8. <u>Fire Chief Report</u>

- Autistic Kit Donation
 - This donation is from the Autism Council of Utah
 - This is a first of this type of collaboration and donation and we are happy to accept and support this
 - Sensory bags were donated that will help when crews are responding on an autistic patient
 - There are many sensory items, such as noise cancelling headphones
 - This will help crews provide better care
 - Training is pending for crews on how to use the kits
 - The donation was accepted as it falls below the \$5,000 Board approval donation limit
- Fairfield Discussion Update
 - A meeting is scheduled next week to present the Community Risk Assessment
- Insurance Update
 - At the August meeting, the contingent funding insurance amount showed a large increase of \$250,000-300,000
 - An updated amount has been provided and has shown a drastic decline to \$21,000
 - As a reminder, UFA is responsible for 80% and personnel 20%
 - Staff feels that this is still the best way to manage insurance as personnel does a great job with their health care use
 - Chief Burchett and CFO Hill feel that this total cost can be covered with vacancy savings in the insurance line item
 - It is surmised that the amount of claims at years-end readjusted following a spike, to account for the swing in cost
- Strategic Plan Captain Quinn
 - Captain Quinn plans to host a zoom meeting for many who were unable to attend the inperson meetings held throughout the service area in the past weeks
 - The data is 60% processed and is showing some great trends

- A Strategic Plan Process will take place at the October Board Meeting for both UFA and UFSA
